School Uniform Policy

School uniform is cost effective for all families. A uniform is an important part of establishing a school image, in giving students a sense of belonging and in identifying the school on excursions and sporting events. It also removes the peer pressure to wear expensive designer clothes and shoes that are not suited to school.

Suttontown students are expected to wear school uniform at all times.

The uniform consists of:

- For allmaroon windcheater/hoodie
gold or maroon polo top
Suttontown hat or a maroon wide-brimmed hat (terms 1 & 4)
maroon school shorts, maroon track pants, maroon school trousers
- Footwear black school shoes school sandals sneakers
- For girls maroon check dress or polo dress, maroon skirt, maroon skort.
- Jewellery watches, studs or sleeper earrings, medic-alert bracelets

The school stocks polo shirts and school hats. Other items can be purchased locally at Big W, K-Mart, Best & Less and Hip Pocket. The school does uniform orders several times a year from a uniform supplier.

Monogramming is available at Hip Pocket.

While every effort is given to training children to wear smocks and being responsible for clothing, the uniform is children's "<u>work-wear</u>" and children will be required to participate in all areas of the curriculum.

Exclusions

- No other accessories or jewellery are acceptable
- Make up
- Clothing with brand names, slogans, stripes on pants, writing or pictures
- Denim
- Non-school hats
